> We supported our family of freelance artists through a **SERIES OF INITIATIVES** to keep them healthy, inspired and creative, including our Spring Forward programme which awarded bursaries to **60 DANCE ARTISTS**, helping them to diversify their skills and experience during this time offstage.

Throughout the pandemic, we delivered online workshops to over 3,000 YOUNG PEOPLE, EMERGING ARTISTS AND COMMUNITY PARTICIPANTS. 

Our 2018–20 tour of Swan Lake saw **3 DANCERS** from the young ensemble make their professional debuts with the company and a **FURTHER 2** with Romeo and Juliet in 2019.
